APPLICATION FOR MINOR DEGREE IN THE HISTORY OF ART AND ARCHITECTURE

Students wanting to pursue a minor in the History of Art and Architecture must file an application form with the department. When the department receives notice of the student's intent to graduate, the minor advisor will check the record against the requirements. The Department of the History of Art and Architecture will then notify the Registrar of the satisfactory completion of the minor. The notation, "Minor in Art History," will appear on the final transcript. The requirements for a minor in HA&A are as follows:

Minor Degree Requirements:

- 3 Lower-Division ARH Courses
- 4 Upper-Division ARH Courses
- Total number of credits needed for the minor is minimum of 26 credits
- At least 20 credits must be completed in residence at UO (non-transfer courses)
- All ARH courses required for the minor must be passed with an equivalent of C- or better.

Lower-Division Art History Courses

3 courses

Any 100- or 200-level ARH courses, or
ARH 314 and/or ARH 315 (History of Word Architecture I and II)
